Dr. Hite:

I am writing not only in my capacity as Chairman of the Pennsylvania Republican Party, but as a former student of Central High School.

While at Central, I and my classmates enjoyed strenuous debate in Social Studies classes about the events of the day. While teachers usually leaned toward the left, they did not seek to indoctrinate and certainly did not hand out campaign materials on behalf of a particular party or advocate partisan views.

So, as you might imagine, I was dismayed to learn that the attached handout that is being distributed by Thomas Quinn, the Social Studies Department Head at Central High School.

As you will see from the attached image, which is a snapshot of the handout, what is being given students by Mr. Quinn is troubling on a number of levels.

First, this is a direct violation of the School District of Philadelphia's teacher handbook prohibition against political activity.

As you will note from section 1.3(F)(2) of the employee handbook, which reads:

"The use of pupils for writing or addressing political material or the distribution of such material to or by pupils is forbidden."

Second, as an alumnus of Central High School, I am deeply disturbed that liberal indoctrination is allowed to be perpetuated in the halls of our public school.

In an environment that should be a-political, allowing students to make up their own minds based on reason, logic and history, the activity by Mr. Quinn is the antithesis of reasonable public school activity and a flagrant refutation of the notion that a variety of viewpoints should be heard, debated and given respect.

How would a student, outspoken about their support for conservative views, feel about being in Mr. Quinn's class? Being graded by him?

This is a very serious matter.

I hope the School District of Philadelphia will undertake an investigation of this matter and provide redress in a manner sufficient and in compliance with the employee handbook and school district regulations.
